Ok but first— what is a Discord server? And how does it work??? **

Discord is a social network and communication app that functions in your browser, a desktop app, or on your mobile device which allows you to communicate in text channels as well as voice and video chats with your community. Unlike Facebook or Instagram, a Discord server is for a limited group of users who have something in common (in this case, MoHA!). Channels within the server are for different interests and topics, as well as for different groups within the MoHA community.





As you can see in the key to the left, each brightly colored section corresponds with a different area of Discord to let you know where you can explore channels, navigate to your profile, write a comment with as many gifs and emojis as your heart desires, shoot a DM, find your friends, see who's online, and check your inbox.





Additionally, there are also a few more quick features scattered around the interface represented as **icons** similar to the **inbox symbol** boxed in red in the top right corner. In the interface you can hover without clicking your pointer over each icon and a description of their function will pop up as long as you hold it there. You can find those descriptions and corresponding icon images below.

SERVERS:

Servers are the spaces on Discord. They are made by **specific communities** and **friend groups**. The vast majority of servers are small and invitation-only. Some larger servers are public. Any user can start a new server for free and invite their friends to it.

CHANNELS:

Discord servers are organized into **text and voice channels**, which are usually dedicated to **specific topics** and **can have different rules**.

PING:

A ping is, essentially, **a notification**—primarily for smartphones. When someone sends a "ping," in particular, they get **a popup on their phone (or desktop application)**, if they belong to the group pinged.

SOFT PING:

When you type something in a ping channel without using the @ symbol, this is called a soft ping. Some people will change the default settings and prevent these types of pings to cut down on phone notifications.

MODS:

Moderators **ensure** that their Discord server is **a safe**, **healthy environment** for everyone. They can do things like moderate or delete messages, as well as invite, ban, or suspend people who violate the server's rules.



SERVER-WIDE MUTE

Simplest addition first. Instead of muting each channel individually, you can check the mute server box to auto-mute each channel within the server. Keep in mind, this is a blanket mute, and isn't selective. You'll notice that the bell icons next to channel names don't update when this option is selected, but all of the options in the notification settings blur out:



Awesome. Remember, this will mute:

- ALL NOTIFICATIONS.
- ALL CHANNELS.
- IN THE SELECTED SERVER.

*With the exception of @everyone mentions. This also means you won't get Mobile Push

Notifications if you switch over to mobile. More on that in a bit.

Starting with the selection on the top, the circular option selections actually apply to each channel in a similar blanket format as the mute server option, but with the added option of allowing us to choose different levels of notifications.

Clicking an option in the Server Notifications Settings updates all of our settings instantly:

The Suppress @everyone option disables any @everyone mention from generating a notification, on the entire server.


• The Mobile Push Notifications option means any notification you'd normally get adds a push notification on your Android / iOS device if you're signed on with the same account! Super handy!

CHANNEL NOTIFICATION SETTINGS


The last section of the notification settings menu lets you adjust individual settings per channel. Use the Notification Overrides section to select different channels in a dropdown. There are a few settings to explore here:



Just like before, you can mute individual channels entirely by selecting mute. You can still do this on the main channel page, but here you can quickly address problem channels in a list fashion.



Even after each channel updates based on how you selected your server notification settings, you can make individual channel notification selections in the scroll down menu as well.
